The Fédération nationale des conseils scolaires francophones (National Federation of French-Language School Boards - FNCSF) represents French-language school boards in Canada outside the province of Quebec.

The FNCSF comprises all French-language school boards located in nine provinces and three territories.

These French-language school boards are composed of more than 700 elementary and secondary schools (kindergarten to grade 12) that collectively serve some 173,000 students.

The FNCSF is recognized as a national strategic leader in the development of French-language education in minority settings.



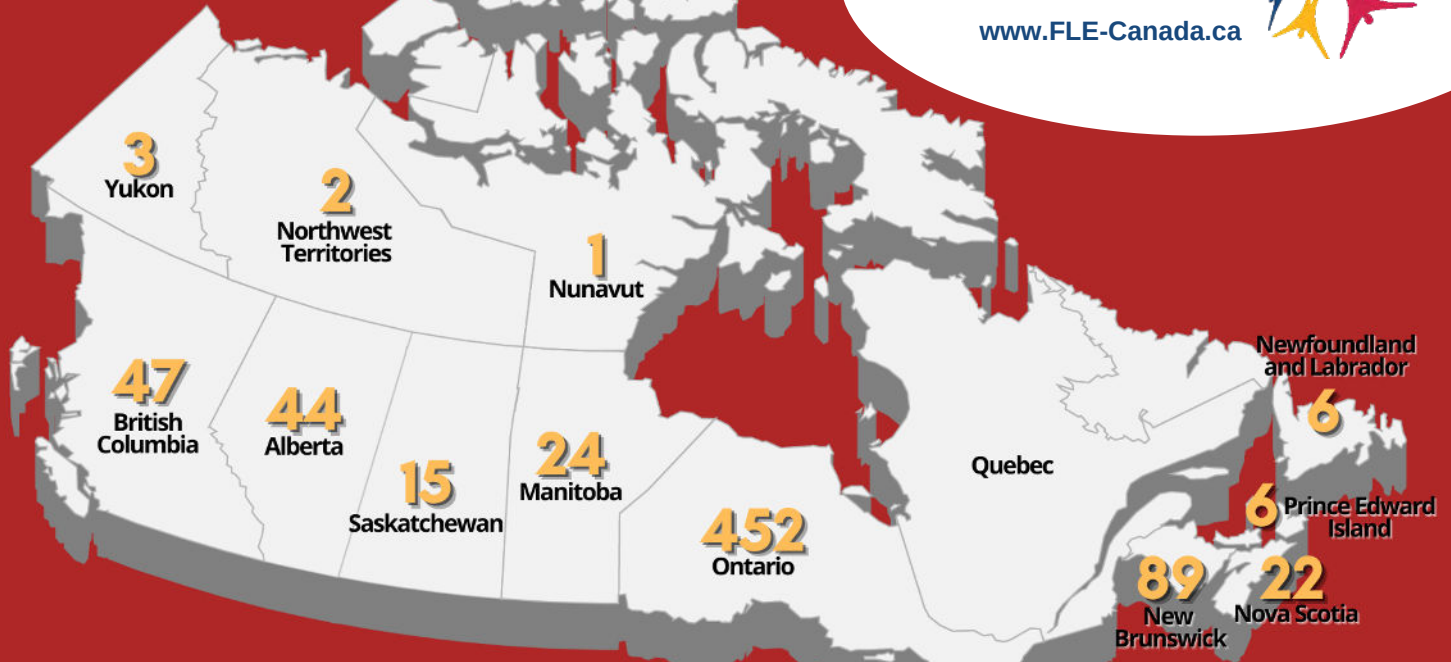
OUR MEMBERS
