

ABOUT THE FNCSF

The Fédération nationale des conseils scolaires francophones (National Federation of French-Language School Boards - FNCSF) represents Frenchlanguage school boards in Canada outside the province of Quebec.

The FNCSF comprises all French-language school boards located in nine provinces and three territories.

These French-language school boards are composed of more than 700 elementary and secondary schools (kindergarten to grade 12) that collectively serve some 180,000 students.

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The FNCSF defends the interest of its members therefore contributing to the vitality of Frenchlanguage schools and, consequently, to the sustainability of Francophone and Acadian communities.

The FNCSF is recognized as a national strategic leader in the development of French-language education in minority settings.


OUR MEMBERS
