Welcoming, accessible, and valued across the country.

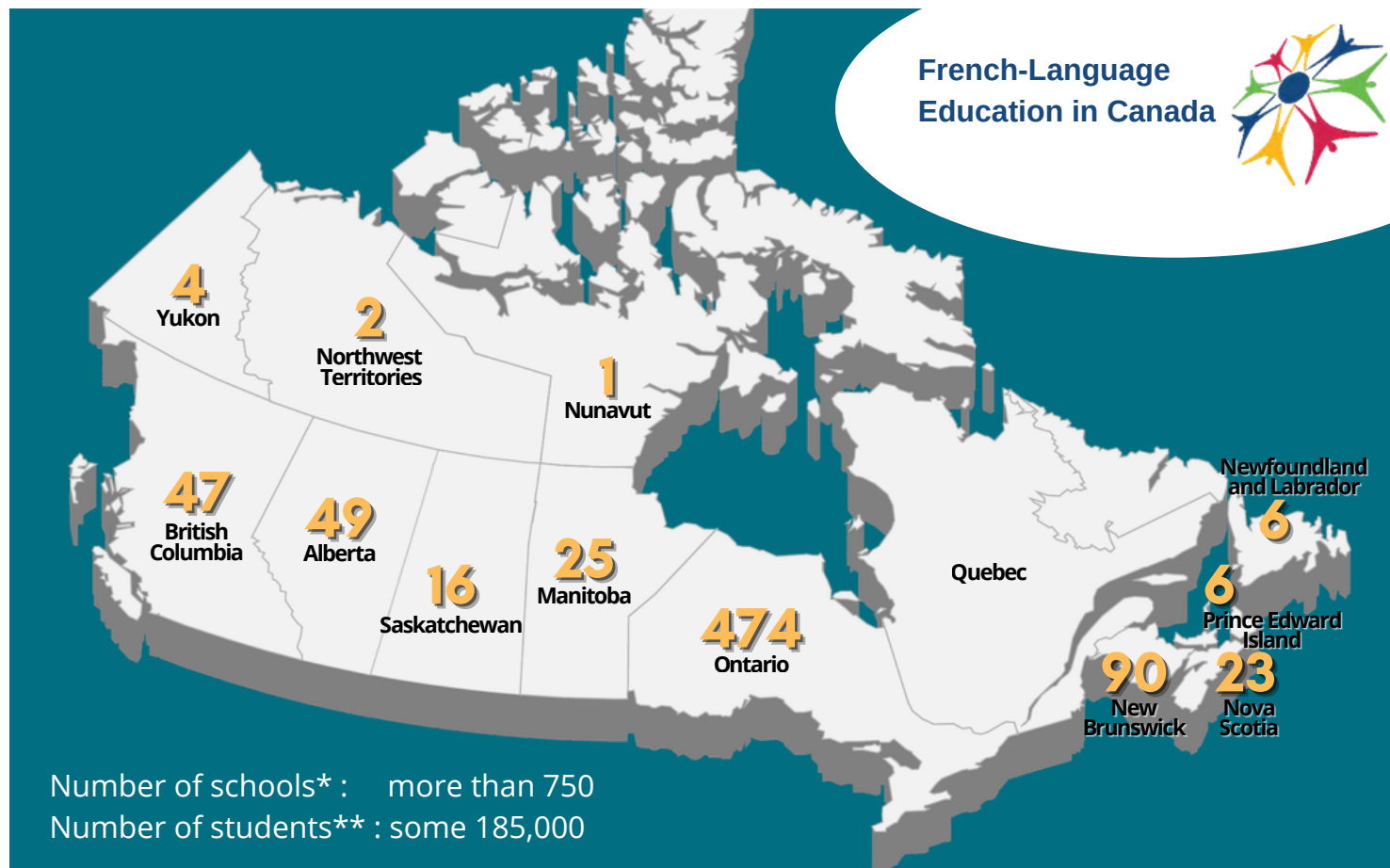


OUR MEMBERS
